Subj: Proposed Amendment to the National Administrative Procedures, Chapter Six, Section 6050 Charter Voluntary Surrender.

In accordance with the Bylaws Article XI, Sections 1100, and National Administrative Procedures Section 10020 the following is submitted for consideration by the body assembled at the 2024 National Convention.

CURRENT SECTION:

Section 6050 Charter Voluntary Surrender

a.

...(2) Upon consideration of the voluntary surrender of the Detachment charter by the Detachment, if it shall be determined that the Detachment charter shall be voluntarily surrendered and there is not a minimum of fifteen (15) members of the detachment who remain ready, willing, and able to carry on the Detachment, then:

PROPOSED SECTION:

Section 6050 Charter Voluntary Surrender (Proposed change in Red).

a.

...(2) Upon consideration of the voluntary surrender of the Detachment charter by the Detachment, if it shall be determined that the Detachment charter shall be voluntarily surrendered and there is not a minimum of fifteen (15) regular members of the detachment who remain ready, willing, and able to carry on the Detachment, then:

CHANGE RATIONALE: Section 6045 Charter Suspension, Revocation indicates that "the charter of a Detachment may be suspended or revoked for ...: (1) The persistent failure to maintain a minimum of fifteen (15) regular members in good standing. The need for consistency in the requirements for the detachments to meet minimum numbers it is imperative that there is a distinction between (all) members and regular members when a charter is surrendered, suspended or revoked. This is further justified, in that Associate members have limited privileges and cannot vote on anything that would impact Marine Corps League policy or bylaws.
